## **1. Terms**

The Client (purchaser) and the Designer (Bogus Cheesecake) agree to adhere to the stipulations listed in the Terms & Conditions. These terms are agreed upon at time of acceptance by the Designer to perform services for the Client. The Designer must be provided credit for "Layout and Typesetting Services" within the project wherever providing attribution is customary.

The Designer agrees to render services to the Client in exchange for a predetermined rate to be determined before the acceptance of the Designer to perform services. Compensation is to be provided after the work is completed but before the final version of the work is provided by the Designer to the Client, and will be provided by the Client through PayPal digital services.

The Designer retains the right to refuse, reject, or suspend their rendering of services to the Client at any time, with or without prior notice, for any reason. If compensation has been provided to the Designer, the Designer will refund any compensation provided back to the Client. Following these terms, the Client is forbidden from utilizing any of the services provided by the Designer in any commercial or non-commercial products.

## **2. Services Provided**

The Designer agrees to provide layout and typesetting services to the client to the extent discussed, upon acceptance by the Designer to provide said services. The Designer agrees to provide fair, professional, and suitable layout and typesetting services to a degree satisfactory to the Client. Work is completed using Affinity Publisher and publicly licensed imagery, as well as imagery provided by the Client.

The Client agrees to provide preliminary information to be referenced for the design of the layout and typesetting services. After information is provided, the Designer will furnish a preliminary draft displaying sample pages to the Client for approval and feedback. If necessary, the Designer will furnish a second and third preliminary draft. The Designer will proceed with the Client's approval.

The Designer will provide a secondary draft containing the full project to the Client for approval. The Client may provide feedback, requests, and desired adjustments. The Designer agrees to provide additional drafts to the Client until satisfaction is met, not to exceed more than 4 rounds of adjustments.

The Client will provide the agreed-upon payment to the Designer, following which, the Designer will furnish a completed final draft to the Client. The final version will contain 300 DPI images in a PDF format with the Designer's watermarks removed. PSD files and other files will be provided upon Client's request. The Designer will retain the original files for safekeeping for a minimum of 30 days for the convenience of the Client.

The Designer retains the right to utilize excerpts of the final version for advertising and portfolio purposes. In public advertising, the Designer agrees not to utilize more than three (3) pages of the Client's final version in order to protect the Client's personal and/or commercial interests.
